Operational Policy 04 (OP-04): Entertainment Committee Terms of Reference

Summary:

The Union recognizes the provision of entertainment opportunities as a central component of its contribution to the lives of its members. As such, the Entertainment Committee is established and maintained as a Standing Committee of the Union by Bylaw IV, Section 6, Sub-section a). This policy serves to outline the operations of the Entertainment Committee in fulfilling its responsibilities as described in Bylaw IV, Section 6, Sub-section d), Item i.

Policy:

- I. The Entertainment Committee shall:
 - a. Develop for recommendation to the Board of Directors no later than July 15 an annual Entertainment Plan, which shall include:
 - i. Recommendations on instalments of Back to School BBQs;
 - ii. Recommendations on instalments of Clubs Day;
 - iii. Recommendations on instalments of Outdoor Movie Nights;
 - iv. Recommendations on instalments of the Common Voices Lecture Series;
 - v. Recommendations on the Last Class Bash;
 - b. Coordinate and report to the Board of Directors on the implementation of all aspects of the Entertainment Plan;
- II. The membership of the Entertainment Committee shall be as described in Bylaw IV, Section 6, Sub-section d), Item ii.
