## **Operational Policy 19 (OP-19): Donations**

Adopted by:Board of DirectorsAdopted on:March 22, 2011

## Summary:

The Union may make monetary or in-kind donations to external individuals or organisations. These donations shall be subject to approval through the following process.

## Policy:

- I. For the purposes of this policy, the following shall be defined as donations:
  - a. Monetary or in kind support provided to external individuals or organisations without expectation of receipt of goods or services;
  - b. Monetary or in kind support provided to members or internal organisations outside established mechanisms, and without expectation of receipt of goods or services;
- II. For the purposes of this policy, the following shall not be defined as donations:
  - a. Monetary or in kind support provided through established mechanisms and services, including, but not limited to, the TRUSU Endowment Fund, TRUSU Grants, and Club services;
  - b. Payments made in exchange for specified goods or services;
- III. Donations shall be approved by the following process:
  - a. Requests and proposals for donations must be made in writing;
  - b. Requests and proposals for donations will be reviewed by the Executive Committee, which may:
    - i. Determine the allocation of a donation, and report it to the following Board of Directors meeting;
    - ii. Refer the request or proposal to the Board of Directors for determination, with a recommendation;
  - c. Requests and proposals for donations exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1000) may only be approved by the Board of Directors.
