Authorities Must Ensure The Safety Of The Ahmadiyya Community In West Nusa Tenggara Province

Dear General,

On behalf of the Thompson Rivers University Students' Union we are writing to urge you to ensure the safety of the 23 **Ahmadiyya** members in Gereneng village and take steps to ensure that all other **Ahmadiyya** members in West Nusa Tenggara Province are protected from forced evictions. Furthermore, to ensure that all those involved in the attack against the **Ahmadiyya** community are brought to justice in line with international standards and that victims are provided reparations. Finally, we urge you to facilitate and guarantee the safe, voluntary, and dignified return of the **Ahmadiyya** community to their homes, and to provide assistance to enable them to rebuild the homes that were damaged or destroyed.

We are deeply troubled by reports from Amnesty International of a coordinated attack against the **Ahmadiyya** community in Gereneng village resulting in destroyed homes and property, and forcing the evacuation of 23 individuals from the village.

We urge you to continue to protect the **Ahmadiyya** community in Gereneng village, to investigate this attack and bring perpetrators to justice, and to facilitate the safe return of the **Ahmadiyya** community to their homes.

Thank you for your attention to this urgent matter.
